Accessibility Plan

Statement of Plan:

The SEN and Disability Act 2001 extended the Disability Discrimination Act 1995 (DDA) to cover education. Since September 2002, Dixons Music Primary has three key duties towards disabled pupils, under part 4 of the DDA:

- Not to treat disabled pupils less favourably for a reason related to their disability;
- To make reasonable adjustments for disabled pupils, so they are not at a substantial disadvantage;
- To plan to increase the access to education for disabled pupils

Details of Plan:

The plan sets out the proposals for the Head of School to increased access to education for disabled pupils in the three areas required by the planning duties in the DDA:

- Increasing the extent to which disabled pupils can participate in the school curriculum;
- Improving the environment of the school to increase the extent to which disabled pupils can take advantage of education and associated services
- Improving the delivery to disabled pupils of the information which is provided in writing for pupils who are not disabled

It is a requirement that the school's accessibility plan is resourced, implemented, reviewed and revised as necessary and reported on annually. What follows is a set of action plans showing how the Academy will address the priorities identified in the plan. *Accessibility Plan 3*
